Responsible for ensuring the safety of facility patrons by preventing and responding to emergencies.

Minimum Qualification:

- · Current certification in the following:
- · American Red Cross Lifeguard Training r.12 (New Course)
- · American Red Cross First Aid
- · American Red Cross CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer
- · American Red Cross Blood Borne Pathogens
- · Must be at least 15 years old
- · Pre-employment testing required by local or state laws

Knowledge And Skills:

- ·Thorough knowledge and application of life guarding surveillance and rescue techniques
- · An understanding of facility characteristics, rules, policies, and procedures
- · Leadership and public relations skills
- · Decision-making skills

Responsibilities:

- · Recognize and respond effectively in emergencies.
- · Recognize and respond to dangerous behaviors.
- · Recognize and respond to a drowning victim within 30 seconds.
- · Enforce all aquatic facility policies, rules, and regulations.
- · Inspect the facility on a daily schedule and report any unsafe conditions or equipment to the supervisor.
- · Assist Jr. Guards with their daily duties.
- · Assist with swim lessons.
- · Complete records and reports.
- · Test and log the water chlorine and pH levels every 2 hours.
- · Maintain an accurate patron count.
- · Participate in regular In-Service training session at least twice a day.
- · Exercise regularly to maintain fitness level (strength and endurance).
- · Take inventory and inspect equipment for Learn-To-Swim Program.
- · Assist lifeguards in providing first aid as necessary.
- · Welcome (with a smile) every patron/group to our facility (upon their arrival).
- ·Thank (with a smile) every patron/group for swimming at our facility upon their leaving).
- · Complete additional duties as assigned by supervisor.
