Recreation Leader/Instructor

Job Description:

A recreational leader plans, organizes, and oversees recreational activities for a variety of organizations. Under general supervision, assists in organizing and leading activities for children and adults in the City's recreation programs; provides on-site supervision for program implementation; provides facilities oversight and set-up during scheduled activities, when assigned to facilities monitoring; and maintains a variety of records.

Responsibilities:

- •Plan activities: Design and organize recreational programs, including sports, arts and crafts, and education programs
- •Lead activities: Lead groups in activities, such as games, crafts, and sports
- •Supervise participants: Ensure participants are safe and engaged, and enforce safety rules
- •Manage schedules: Schedule sports programs and the use of facilities
- •Maintain records: Keep records of equipment use and participant payments and rosters
- Promote activities: Create displays and advertisements for events, and provide information to the public
- •Maintain facilities: Ensure that facilities and equipment are used and maintained properly
- Ability to establish & maintain good working relationship with co-workers, campers & parents.
- · Assists in controlling conduct of our youth in the park/camp, in according to park/camp rules.
- · Assists in directing tournaments, socials, dances, exhibits, and special events;
- · Assists supervisor in coaching, instructing, or setting up leagues and programs.
- · Assists supervisor in securing technical information needed for any type of reports or programs.
- · Assists supervisor, in all park related events or activities.
- · Checks bathrooms to make sure no loitering is taking place.

· Enforce Safety Precautions!!

- * Informs immediate supervisor on arrival and departure.
- · Leads a variety of recreational activities in a recreation center;
- · Must attend and assist on field trips.
- · Must be able to work with all children, maintain order, and control his/her group.
- · Must have knowledge of subject, be energetic, and creative.
- · Must have some knowledge of first aid & CPR.
- · Must have some knowledge of subject, be energetic, and creative.
- · Oversees assigned functional areas of the center reports to Recreation Supervisor/Coordinator or Recreation Director on activities, plans and problems;
- · Oversees the use of equipment and supplies.
- · Recommends action and carries out policies in dealing with specific groups.
- · Report all medical problems (sickness or injuries) to supervisor in charge at your site.
- \cdot See that debris is put in trash containers and area is cleaned at the conclusion of lunch period.
- · Any Other Related Duties.

Recreation leaders often work outside of regular business hours, as programs may run in the evenings and on weekends
